

## **How to Become a Member of the Cape St. Claire Swim Club**

### **Buying a Membership in the Cape St. Claire Swim Club**

1. Join the Yahoo group cape pool membership at  
<http://groups.yahoo.com/group/capepoolmemberships/>

This e-mail group is intended to help connect potential purchasers of CSCSC memberships with potential sellers of memberships. You may post a want ad or respond to an offer of sale using this group. This is a good way to locate a potential seller and negotiate a private sale. Occasionally the club will have a membership to sell. The club will offer the membership through the yahoo group on a first come first served basis.

2. Once you have located a seller and struck a deal you must provide a written recommendation from a current (not selling) member in good standing to your seller and provide the information they need to complete the Membership sale form. Your transaction is contingent upon approval for membership by the CSCSC Board which meets monthly.

3. You will be responsible for dues annually (2011 Season dues are \$450 – there are additional fees for guest cards, swim lessons and swim team.) All eligible CSCSC members will be accepted on the swim team provided registration and fees are received by the Swim Team registration deadline. Look for relevant dates, eligibility requirements and information on the pool website.

4. Please make yourself aware of all club rules and requirements before purchasing a membership.

## **Leasing a Membership in the Cape St. Claire Swim Club**

1. Go to the CSCSC website at [www.capepool.com](http://www.capepool.com). Print out and complete the Lease application form, mail to Cape St. Claire Swim Club, Inc., Suite 351, 1332 Cape St. Claire Rd., Annapolis, Maryland 21409. This form does not guarantee a lease, and does not constitute a lease until approved and signed by the CSCSC board. Leases will be given to those approved by the CSCSC board on a first come, first served basis. If no leases are available, your full payment will be returned.
2. You may also seek a lease by joining the yahoo group mentioned above. Many members may their memberships privately.
3. Leases are not guaranteed from one year to the next. The best way to guarantee you will have use of the pool is to buy a membership.
